

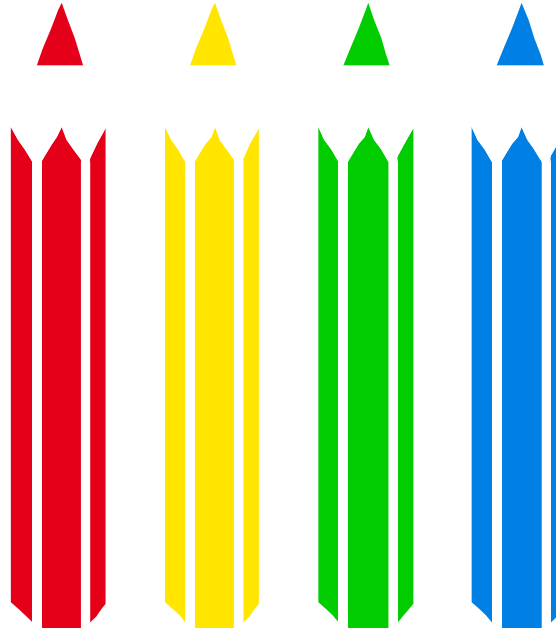
Cancellation Policy

Registration Fees

A registration/supply fee is charged for each child at the time of pre-registration and is nonrefundable.

Class Fees

Class fees are due the first day of each month. A \$12 late fee is added if not paid by the first. There will be no refunds issued for student absences, including illness.
