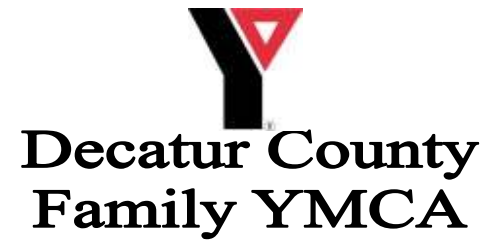

Adult Racquetball Leagues

F.Y.I

- The league is open to all skill levels (A/B,C and D) and is co-ed
- Anyone over the age of 16 may play
- The league runs 6 weeks

- Certain hours will be blocked off for league only. On a first come first serve basis

Matches

- 1.) To start the match the players will lag to the back service line. The winner is the one closest before or after the line, will get to go first. The second game will go to the player that did not serve in the first game.
 - 2.) Each match is a best of 3, so the results will be either 2-0 or 2-1. Play 2 games to 15 points. If necessary, play a tiebreaker game to 11 points. First player to reach 15 or 11 points wins.
 - 3.) In the event of a 3rd game, the player with the highest point spread will serve first.
 - 4.) Match Scoring: 1 point for each game won, 1 point for winning the match (example: Bill beats Bob 2 games to 1. Bill would get 3 points Bob would get 1 point). Matches not played during scheduled week result in 0 points for each player (unless approved by YMCA director).
 - 5.) Score book will be kept at YMCA front desk. Match winner fills out score sheet in book after match.
 - 6.) League Winner Tie-break system: 1)Most Points 2)Head-to-Head results 3) 1 match play-off
- 4.) The league tries to follow the Official USRA rules but, without officials, turn to the USRA Basic Self-Officiating rules when applicable. All players are especially encouraged to review USRA 3.9 Fault Serves and 3.15 Avoidable Hinders. **LOCAL SCREEN SERVES RULE:** In the event of second-serve screen called by the receiving player, the server will be allowed another second serve.

Divisions

- A/B Divisions** - Veteran, experienced players that can use have an effective backhand, good positioning.
- C Division** - Intermediate level players with a fair knowledge of the game, including court positioning.
- D Division** - Beginning players, new to the sport.

NO SHOWS:

A no-show without a call to your opponent will count as a forfeit in the standings and repeat offenders won't be invited back next season.

In the event of a no-show, 30 minutes is the required wait time before declaring a forfeit.

Emergencies can happen to anyone, but a no-show without a call to your opponent will count as a forfeit in the standings and repeat offenders won't be invited back next season.

Forfeit = 3 points
